## Example 1.2 Shape Tween

This example shows the basics of creating a shape tween in Flash 5. In the example four red squares each morph into a letter spelling out the word "VISC".

Step 1: $\quad$ Create new movie

- File > New or <CTRL><N>

Step 2: $\quad$ lick on the rectangle tool in the tool bar

Step 3: Deselect the square border with no color button


Step 4: Draw a small red square on the left side of the stage (approx. 2-3 cm)

Step 5: $\quad$ Copy and paste three identical squares, each a little to the right of the previous square. You should have 4 total squares side by side

Step 6: Align the squares perfectly by bringing up the align panel

- Window > Panels > Align
- Using the arrow tool, select all 4 of the squares
- Vertically align the squares with 므
- Horizontally align the squares with 미

Step 7: Add a key frame to frame 15

- Select frame 15
- Insert > Key Frame or <F6>

Step 8: Add the word "VISC" to the stage

- Select the texttool A from the tools bar
- Write the word "VISC" in black

Step 9: Position "VISC" With the arrow tool drag the word "VISC" until the "V" is in the center of the first red square on your stage.

## Example 1.2 Shape Tween (cont.)

Step 10: In the Character panel Window > Panels > Character

- Widen the text with the characterwidening tool until each character of VISC is in the middle of a square


Step 11: Remove squares for the layer

- Click the each red square behind the black letters
- Hit <DELETE>
*Caution - This should leave you with just the black word "VISC" on the stage of the $15^{\text {th }}$ frame

Step 12: Break apart the word "VISC"

- Select the text box, Modify > Break Apart

Step 13: Select contents of Layer

- Click anywhere in the timeline between the 1 and 15 frame

Step 14: Create Shape tween from the Frame Panel


Step 15: Preview Movie
(Squares should shape tween into the word "VISC", one letter per square)

- <ENTER> or <F12> or <CTRL><ENTER>
